I further authorise any officers, coaches and team managers of Venetians in the event of such an accident, injury, disease or illness to obtain the necessary medical assistance or treatment and for this purpose engage any medical, ambulance and nursing assistance and/or hospital treatment and in this event, I agree to pay all such fees and expenses and any fees and expenses incurred by Venetians, these said fees to be paid to Venetians on demand.



SUMMARY OF WDNA AND VENETIAN'S CODE OF CONDUCT

The Player Code

- Play for the "fun of it" and play by the rules. Never argue with an official. If you disagree, have your Captain, Coach or Manager approach the official during a break or after the match.
- Control your temper. Verbal abuse of committee members, spectators, officials or other players is not acceptable or permitted in any sport.
- Work equally hard for yourself and your team. Your team's performance will benefit and so will you.
- Be a good sport. Applaud all good plays whether they are by your team or the opposition.
- Treat all players as you would be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player.
- Avoid using derogatory language.
- Co-operate with your coach, team-mates, opponents and umpires. Without them there would be no competition.
- Training or playing under the influence of alcohol is not permitted.
- Players who are ill (within reason) and or injured must notify coaches and attend training and games (this is however at the discretion of you/your child's coach).
- Players must wear the Venetians training singlet to all training sessions.

The Parent and Spectator Code

- Encourage children to play by the rules.
- Focus on your child's effort and development rather than the overall outcome of the game.
- Any commentary should be positive in nature and you should recognise and encourage good play or efforts.
- Respect the efforts and decisions of volunteer coaches and do not publicly question an official's decision.
- Do not approach a player during the breaks or team huddles unless instructed by the coach or team manager.
- Refrain from coaching your child or other players during games and practices.
- Condemn the use of violence in any form, be it by spectators, coaches, officials or players.
- Show respect for your team's opponents and umpires. Without them there would be no game.
- Encourage players to follow the rules and the officials' decisions.
- Respect and support the decisions of our parent bodies (WDNA, Netball WA, Netball Australia).

REFUNDS

WDNA do not offer full fee refunds after the Netball WA registration date has closed on 27th May 2024. If an injury occurs, refunds can be applied for in writing to the club President.

(Please note that injury insurance towards some of your treatment costs is available as part of the Netball WA fees.)

Any player that withdraws after WDNA registration, may only receive the club portion, minus an administration charge, pending the reason supplied.

FUNDRAISING

<u>All members</u> are required to fundraise by participating in the chocolate drive. We will allocate **one box per player**.

Chocolate boxes will be handed out at on the first training date for all players except for non-training. All players will have 4 weeks to sell their boxes of chocolates.

If you would like to opt out of selling chocolates, you can pay a \$30.61 fundraising levy.

NB: All Non-training players will be required to pay the \$30.61 fundraising levy.

If you choose to pay the fundraising levy you must select this option when registering.

There will be an option to add it as a product before payment.

Please note, the levy MUST be paid through PlayHQ when registering or you will be allocated a box of chocolates to sell.



Optional Products

The following items are available for purchase, however they are optional.



Players who do not pay or fail to return chocolate money will be <u>unfinancial</u> and not be able to train or play until payment is made.

HOW TO REGISTER

ALL registrations and expressions of interests must be processed through **PlayHQ**. If this is the first time you are using PlayHQ, you will be required to setup a new account. If you need any assistance with registering via PlayHQ please use their <u>support page</u>.

Existing member who DID play Winter in 2023 (training teams only):

Step 2: Log in with your participant ID and password.

Step 3: Complete the Registration Form

Step 4: Add any additional items such as the fundraising levy (optional) and then proceed to the checkout.

Please note:

- 1. Only a portion of fees will be charged at this point. You will be required to fill out a second registration form prior to the commencement of grading which will be emailed to you.
- 2. There will be no payment plans available.
- 3. You must register prior to the 14th January 2024.
- 4. If you are applying for KidSport, you must do so prior to registering as the voucher code must be entered at the checkout.

NON-TRAINING TEAMS

We welcome whole non-training teams. You are responsible for organising a minimum of 9 players for a team.

Your team list must be emailed to prior to registration of any members.

It is a requirement that you supply your own manager (non-playing manager preferred) to help you on Saturdays during the games.

Individual players who are wanting to play non-training will be accepted on availability of places and must register their interest by emailing president@venetiansnetballclub.com.au

Please note that non-training players are required to pay the fundraising levy.





KIDSPORT

Applicants must be aged 5–18 years and have a Health Care Card or Pension Concession Card.

Eligible players must apply via kidsport.dlgsc.wa.gov.au.

You must apply for KidSport <u>prior</u> to registration and enter your code in the checkout in PlayHQ.

Venetians do not manage your application. If codes are not entered at the time of registration, no refund will be able to be given.

You must have your code prior to registering.

TROPHY EVENTS

At the end of the 2024 season we will be holding three events for our teams to get together to celebrate and reflect on the year that has been.

GRADING

Provisional paper grading will occur immediately after registrations have closed, and physical grading will begin on the 4th February 2024. If you fail to attend ALL the grading sessions this may affect the team you are placed in, only players in attendance can be graded on skill level.

For grading, please ensure you are on time, dressed appropriately in sports clothes and sneakers, no jewellery or long nails and bring enough water to get you through the sessions.

Parents/Guardians are requested to sit on the grassed areas, not on the court sidelines. Players who are not on court may sit on the sidelines at the end of the courts away from the graders.

Pre-season Strength and Conditioning

Many of you will already be aware of the strength and conditioning program that has been offered in previous years with Mandy Hopper. In 2024 we welcome Mandy and MH Performance back as a new Gold Sponsor.

For those who do not know of Mandy Hopper, she holds a Masters in Sport Science and is a certified strength and conditioning coach who specialises in netball strength and conditioning. She has been running a netball specific strength and conditioning program for 12 – 17 year old netball athletes for many years and assists athletes in improving performance whilst avoiding knee and ankle injuries. Each term Mandy has approximately 50 girls in the program who have drastically improved their overall body strength, power and speed. In fact, across the entire netball academy group virtually ALL of the girls are 100% injury free!

In addition, many have had results like...

- · Increased jump height
- · Improved running speed
- · Increased self-confidence on and off the court
- · Eliminated knee and ankle pain
- · Eradicated shin splints

In 2024, there will be sessions held during pre-season training with Mandy to ensure our playing members (12& under – open) and coaches are educated about the importance of strength and conditioning. There will also be further opportunities to participate in a series of 10-week programs in her private facilities that are **exclusive to Venetian's members**. The pre-season court sessions will be provided free of charge and the 10-week program will be subsidised by the club.







10-week strength and conditioning programs

This program is available for any member aged 12 years and older. The cost for each of the programs is \$25 per week (\$250 for 10 weeks) and Venetians Netball Club will be subsidising \$100 per athlete for the Term 1 program. Venetians will then continue to subsidise \$50 per athlete for the Term 2,3 and 4 programs. Participants will be required to pay the gap directly to MH Performance. Please note this subsidy is different to the subsidy provided in 2023.

The programs will include pre-testing during the first session to determine the correct program for each athlete and will also involve re-testing athletes at the end of the program to measure their progress. Athletes will attend a 1-hour session once a week at the facility in Wangara. Athletes will have the option to participate in a pre-season program, two in-season programs and one post season program. These will be run at the same time each week.

Term 1 (pre-season): 29th January – 29th March

Term 2 (in season): 15th April – 28th June

Term 3 (in season): 15th July – 20th September

Term 4 (off season): 7th October – 13th December

Level 4 – Australian Netball League
