

2022 Registration Information

Welcome to Venetians Netball Club for the **2022** winter season. We would ask that you please take the time to read the information provided over the following pages as it will assist you with the registration process and provide other information about our club.

This year registrations will be completed on a new platform using PlayHQ and will require full payment at the point of registration. Registrations will commence on the **1st January 2022** for players in **NetSetGO up to 18 & Under** and close by the **31st January 2022**. Acceptance of registration is subject to the availability of places and may result in the registration period closing earlier than stated. We recommend registering as soon as possible to avoid missing out on a place. Late registrations will only be accepted if there are suitable places available.

Open Players: Please note that this year we are staggering our open registrations. Players who played the previous season and existing members will be given priority to register. Registrations for existing members will open on the **1st January 2022** and will close on the **14th January 2022**.

After this date registrations will open for new members depending on positions available from the **17th January 2022** and will close on the **31st January 2022**.

Please note that preference will be given to existing members and to players who are financial with the club, will be playing more than 80% of the season and have a good attendance record.

Prior to registering, all members are required to read and agree to the Membership Agreement, Medical Disclaimer, Venetian's Code of Conduct and WDNA Code of Behaviour. If you are intending on applying for **Kid Sport** this must be done prior to registration as well.

(hereinafter called "Venetians") accepting myself/my child as a playing member and registering myself/my child and keeping myself/my child registered, I, the undersigned, hereby agree to myself/my child attending and participating in all netball activities and agree to and do indemnify Venetians, its committee, coaches and team managers, in so far as to the extent to which Venetians, its committee, coaches and team managers are not entitled to be indemnified under any policy of insurance whatsoever from and against any claims, damages or compensation which may befall or occur to myself/my child during participation in a netball activity or function connected with Venetians or when travelling to or from such activity or function.

I further authorise any officers, coaches and team managers of Venetians in the event of such an accident, injury, disease or illness to obtain the necessary medical assistance or treatment and for this purpose engage any medical, ambulance and nursing assistance and/or hospital treatment and in this event, I agree to pay all such fees and expenses and any fees and expenses incurred by Venetians, these said fees to be paid to Venetians on demand.



SUMMARY OF WDNA AND VENETIAN'S CODE OF CONDUCT

The Player Code

- Play for the “fun of it” and play by the rules. Never argue with an official. If you disagree, have your Captain, Coach or Manager approach the official during a break or after the match.
- Control your temper. Verbal abuse of committee members, spectators, officials or other players is not acceptable or permitted in any sport.
- Work equally hard for yourself and your team. Your team’s performance will benefit and so will you.
- Be a good sport. Applaud all good plays whether they are by your team or the opposition.
- Treat all players as you would be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player.
- Avoid using derogatory language.
- Co-operate with your coach, team-mates, opponents and umpires. Without them there would be no competition.
- Training or playing under the influence of alcohol is not permitted.
- Players who are ill (within reason) and or injured must notify coaches and attend training and games (this is however at the discretion of you/your child’s coach).
- Players must wear the Venetians training singlet to all training sessions.

The Parent and Spectator Code

- Encourage children to play by the rules.
- Focus on your child’s effort and development rather than the overall outcome of the game.
- Any commentary should be positive in nature and you should recognise and encourage good play or efforts.
- Respect the efforts and decisions of volunteer coaches and do not publicly question an official’s decision.
- Do not approach a player during the breaks or team huddles unless instructed by the coach or team manager.
- Refrain from coaching your child or other players during games and practices.
- Condemn the use of violence in any form, be it by spectators, coaches, officials or players.
- Show respect for your team’s opponents and umpires. Without them there would be no game.
- Encourage players to follow the rules and the officials’ decisions.
- Respect and support the decisions of our parent bodies (WDNA, Netball WA, Netball Australia).

COVID-19 UPDATE

As many of you will be aware there have been changes announced by the State Government as a part of the Safe Transition Plan for Western Australia. This includes the requirement to show **proof of vaccination** to attend large events of 1000+ people.

On match days the number of people at the Kingsway netball courts exceeds 1,000 and WDNA have requested advice from Netball WA on what this means for members of the Association. They are also awaiting information on whatever requirements the City of Wanneroo may place on the facility. However, specific procedures and information on restrictions may not be available until closer to the start of the 2022 season and we need to be prepared.

We would like our members and potential members to consider what this means for them before registering for the 2022 Winter Season. It is likely that there may be restrictions on spectators permitted in the complex and it can be assumed that **all spectators and players over the age of 12 will be required to show proof of vaccination or medical exemption.**

If you are not currently vaccinated and are not planning on getting vaccinated, then we would recommend that you do not register for the 2022 season. If you are not vaccinated and are planning on getting vaccinated, then we recommend getting this done as soon as possible as you may not be able to participate in pre-grading skills sessions or grading if you are not fully vaccinated.

PlayHQ

Mynetball has become obsolete, and all members will now be required to register via **PlayHQ**. If this is the first time you are using PlayHQ; you will be required to setup a new account. If you need any assistance with registering via PlayHQ please use their support page. Which can be found by clicking the link below.

A couple of the main differences you should take note of are listed below.

- Payment is in full at the time of registration.
- There will be no payment plans available.
- If you are applying for Kid Sport, the voucher code has to be entered in the checkout to get your benefits. You must apply for your voucher prior to registering. **We will not be issuing refunds** for individuals who apply after registration.
- There is a 2.03% service charge applied by PlayHQ for their payment services.

HOW TO REGISTER

Step 1: Visit playHQ by clicking here.

Step 2: Log in with your participant ID and password
OR create a new account (first time users).

Step 3: Complete the Registration Form and update
ALL details.

Step 4: Add any additional items such as the
fundraising levy (optional) and then proceed to the
checkout.

Step 5: Enter Kid Sport voucher code and then select
payment option.



KID SPORT

Applicants must be aged 5–18 years and have a Health Care Card or Pension Concession Card. Eligible players must apply via kidsport.dlgsc.wa.gov.au. You must apply for KidSport **prior** to registration and enter your code in the checkout in PlayHQ.

Venetians do not manage your application. If codes are not received and entered at the time of registration, no refund will be able to be given. **You must have your code prior to registering.**



NON-TRAINING TEAMS

We welcome whole non-training teams. You are responsible for organising a minimum of 9 players for a team.

Your team list must be emailed to president@venetiansnetballclub.com.au prior to registration of any members.

It is a requirement that you supply your own manager (non-playing manager preferred) to help you on Saturdays during the games.

Individual players who are wanting to play non-training will be accepted on availability of places and must register their interest by emailing info@venetiansnetballclub.com.au



TROPHY EVENTS

We hold two events to celebrate the season at the end of the year. These events will take place on the 8th October 2022.

The junior event (NetSetGO to 13 & under) is held over lunch and includes games, dancing, food and soft drink. The open event (15 & under to Open) is held in the evening and includes entertainment, food and a bar and is a more formal occasion. **Both events are for players, coaches, managers and volunteers only.**

Awards are presented at both events for each team and all players in NSG and 11 & under receiving a trophy.

A trophy night ticket for players is included in the overall 2022 fee structure. This is **non-refundable** and payable by all members.

Entertainment, food and soft drink is included in the ticket price and we sometimes have some special guests!

FUNDRAISING

All members are required to fundraise by participating in the chocolate drive OR pay a \$25 fundraising levy. Players who do not pay or fail to return chocolate money will be unfinancial and not be able to take the court until payment is made. If you choose to pay the \$25 fundraising levy you must select this option when registering. There will be an option to add a product before payment.

REFUNDS

WDNA do not offer full fee refunds after the Netball WA registration date has closed in May. If an injury occurs, fee refunds can be applied for in writing to the club President. (Please note that injury insurance towards some of your treatment costs is available as part of the Netball WA fees.) Any player that withdraws after WDNA registration, may only receive the club portion, minus an administration charge, pending the reason supplied.

GRADING

Parents/Guardians are requested to sit on the grassed areas, not on the court sidelines. Players who are not on court may sit on the sidelines at the end of the courts away from the graders.

PURCHASING UNIFORMS IN 2022

All our club uniform items will be able to be purchased before the 2022 season starts from Victory Athletic (Unit 4/12 Mumford Place, Balcatta) and will also be available online via their website.

Victory Athletic will offer our club a designated time for uniform purchases, collections and try-ons during the 2022 netball season via appointment at their Balcatta premises. They will also do 'pop-up' uniform events on some training nights during the season.

Compulsory uniform items for all players are the game day dress, club socks and our training singlet. Victory Athletic will stock hold all of our other optional uniform items including the new club hoodie, sports bags, beanies, scarves, club polos and much, much more!

Pre-season Strength and Conditioning

Many of you will already be aware of the strength and conditioning program that was offered to members aged 12 – 17 years old in 2021 with Mandy Hopper. In 2022, we welcome Mandy and MH Performance back as a silver sponsor and we will be extending our strength and conditioning program further.

For those who do not know of Mandy Hopper, she holds a Masters in Sport Science and is a certified strength and conditioning coach who specialises in netball strength and conditioning. She has been running a netball specific strength and conditioning program for 12 – 17 year old netball athletes for many years and assists athletes in improving performance whilst avoiding knee and ankle injuries. Each term Mandy has approximately 50 girls in the program who have drastically improved their overall body strength, power and speed. In fact, across the entire netball academy group virtually ALL of the girls are 100% injury free!

In addition, many have had results like...

- Increased jump height
- Improved running speed
- Increased self-confidence on and off the court
- Eliminated knee and ankle pain
- Eradicated shin splints

In 2022, there will be sessions held during pre-season training with Mandy to ensure our playing members (12& under – open) and coaches are educated about the importance of strength and conditioning. There will also be further opportunities to participate in a series of 10-week programs in her private facilities that are **exclusive to Venetian's members**. The pre-season court sessions will be provided free of charge and the 10-week program will be subsidised by the club.



10-week strength and conditioning programs

This program is available for any member aged 12 years and older. The cost for each of the programs is \$25 per week (\$250 for 10 weeks) and Venetians Netball Club will be subsidising \$100 per athlete who joins each program. Participants will be required to pay the gap of \$150 to MH Performance.

The programs will include a before screening session to determine the correct program for each athlete and will also involve re-testing athletes at the end of the program to measure their progress. Athletes will attend a 1-hour session once a week at the facility in Wangara. Athletes will have the option to participate in a pre-season program, two in-season programs (dates below) and one post season program. These will be run at the same time each week.
