2019 CLUB INFORMATION

NOTICE TO ALL CLUBS

WDNA Office Hours 2019 – Monday to Friday 8.30 to 4.30pm

*Please note that the phones and emails will not be responded to on **Mondays from May 6th to September 9th** to allow recording of all data to be completed. *

2019 will see the commencement of our new WDNA building so please remember the clubrooms will not be in use for clubs during the season.

Please read the information supplied regarding the 2019 Winter Season carefully. It is most important that all clubs take notice and organise their paperwork and money accordingly so that you can meet your commitments as they fall due. This sheet will provide the necessary information along with the WDNA website www.wdna.net.au.

Clubs will receive their 2019 Affiliation and Contact Information Form along with the 2019 Winter Uniform Registration Form in the AGM Pack. These forms need to be submitted to WDNA as early as possible via email to enquiries@wdna.net.au or mail.

REGISTRATIONS

Registrations will be done by clubs on the Mynetball portal, once all players registered and entered into team lists, clubs will then be required to make an appointment with WDNA to finalise their registrations. Appointments can be made from **Monday March 25 through to Friday April 5**. WDNA will offer varying times to accommodate clubs and invoicing will be done during the registration appointments. WDNA lock out date will be **April 8**. After this date clubs **will not** be able to make any amendments or adjustments to their team lists while grading is completed. Clubs can still send through a mynetball administration form to be actioned by WDNA staff. Mynetball will be reopened to clubs on **Tuesday April 23**.

Registration fees can be worked out on the costing sheet included in the AGM pack. Fees can be paid with all cash, EFT or **ONE** cheque made payable to Wanneroo Districts Netball Association.

As per WDNA Policy and Procedures Ruling 16, **Clubs must pay the full amount of the WDNA fee component at registration appointment**. If you are paying via EFT, you will need to supply a receipt of payment either **before or during** your registration appointment. The balance of Netball WA fees to be paid prior to the first playing date on May 4 2019.

Any clubs not meeting their obligations to pay in full before May 4 will be unable to take the court. This includes any outstanding monies from 2018.

WDNA will be conducting two Club Contact **compulsory** information sessions on **Monday March 11 & Wednesday March 13, 2019 from 6pm to 8.30pm. Venue TBC**

A mynetball session for **NSG** will be held on **Monday February 11 6pm to 8pm and a session for Jnr/Snr on Thursday February 14. Venue TBC.** If you are skilled and experienced in the mynetball system you do not need to attend these sessions. As per the survey our Administration Assistant, Amy Whitehead is available to assist you with your season set up at a cost of \$30.00 per hour. Please advise us if you require this service.

It is a good idea to have more than 2 representatives that know how to use the Mynetball system. **All clubs must be registered mynetball users in 2019.** There is a mynetball user agreement in the AGM pack so please fill out and return to manager@wdna.net.au ASAP.

Clubs will need to advise the office via the enquiries@wdna.net.au email of attendance at these sessions as early as possible. Registration information and Forms will be available for collection by Club Contacts at the 2019 Annual General Meeting held at **WDNA Monday February 4, 2019, 7.30pm. Venue TBC.**

WDNA will forward the recommended changes to the Policy and Procedures in early December to club contacts. Clubs will then be given until **January 18, 2019** to send in any comments or suggestions, so the Board can review at the January Board meeting. There will be **no discussion** on the P & P changes at the **AGM.**

Based on survey results and club recommendations the following competition changes were decided for 2019

- NSG SET/GO games will be on Fridays
- Divisions of 8
- 3 byes in July
- SGV's **will NOT** count towards the five (5) games required to qualify for finals
- NSG GO year 5 will play with a **size 5** ball and full post
- Grading - scores will be monitored in divisions playing for points for the first 4 games and adjustments to divisions may be made by the DOC. Should the teams in a division change then all points and percentages will revert to zero. There will be no further adjustments after week 4.
- Complaints – there will be a \$20.00 fee to lodge a complaint – refunded if complaint goes to mediation or tribunal
- Trial a possible 15 & U mixed competition on Fridays to allow males a pathway. Please advise WDNA asap if you would be interested in entering a team in this separate competition.

The Age Groups for Winter 2019 will be as follows:

NSG (Net) – Born July 2012 – December 2014

NSG (Set) – Year 2 – Born July 2011 – June 2012

NSG (Set) – Year 3 – Born July 1, 2010 – June 30, 2011

NSG (GO) – Year 4 – Born July 1, 2009– June 30, 2010

NSG (GO) – Year 5 – Born July 1, 2008– June 30, 2009

U/11's – Born January 1, 2008 – 31 December 2008

U/12's – Born 2007

U13's – Born 2006

U/15's – Born 2004 & 2005

U/18's – Born 2001, 2002 & 2003

Open – Born 2000 or before

All players can play up one age group from where they are eligible per their birth date without a permit or approval from WDNA.

Any player wishing to play up 2 age groups from where they are eligible per their birth date, including filling in must apply for a permit from WDNA.

Players who are age eligible for NSG (Set/Go) Year 2, 3 & 4 will play by the NSG (Set) modified rules as defined in the **WDNA Policy & Procedures** manual, including a size 4 netball and the netball ring set to 8ft (2.4m). NSG GO year 5 will play with a **size 5** ball and full post.

Clubs will need to set up an NSG Centre registration session to be able to register your NSG players and submit to NWA via mynetball.

Courts required for training and grading purposes between December and February can be requested by emailing the WDNA Association office from December 1st.

PHOTOGRAPHY CONSENT

Clubs will be required to advise WDNA of any photography objections at the time of registrations. If a club does have objections their scorecard will be marked with an alert sticker. This will also be applied for any WDNA umpires that have denied consent. A red sticker will be placed on the scorecard.

2019 PLAYER FEE AND HIRE CHARGES

WDNA fees will remain the same as 2018.

Regional Fees

In previous years each Region would set and collect a Regional Fee from its Members and where agreed, from its NetSetGO Participants. With the introduction of the new Regional Office structure commencing on 1 January 2019, Netball WA will set and collect these Regional Fees from 2019 onwards. The Regional Fee will be standardised across the state, with one consistent fee applied to and payable by all Netball WA Senior and Junior Playing Members across Individual Full, Small Country and Short Season Memberships.

Currently, the various Regional Fees range from \$10.00 - \$22.00 (GST Inclusive). Netball WA has previously communicated through its Regional Office information, that it was aiming to set the 2019 Regional Fees between \$15.00 - \$18.00 (GST Inclusive). Following its extensive Regional Office budget development and projection of Netball WA 2019 Membership numbers, Netball WA can confirm that the **2019 Netball WA Regional Fee will be \$18.00 (GST inclusive) per Senior and Junior Playing Member, as outlined in Table 1. Please note that NetSetGO Participants will not be charged a Regional Fee.**

Netball WA confirms that **all** Regional Fee funds will be fully invested directly into the Regional Office structure and the servicing of Member Associations and Clubs, to ensure the development and growth of netball at community grassroots is the priority moving forward. Although the change in the Regional Fee will vary from region to region for 2019.

Netball WA Membership Fees

The changes to the 2019 Membership Fees are as follows:

- An increase of **\$3.00 (GST inclusive) in the Senior Playing Membership Fee** across Individual Full, Small Country and Short Season memberships;
- An increase of **\$4.00 (GST inclusive) in the Junior Playing Membership Fee** across Individual Full, Small Country and Short Season memberships;
- **Non-Playing Membership Fees** will remain at \$0.00.

Netball WA NetSetGO Participation Fees

There will be two changes to the NetSetGO Participation Fees in 2019. These are as follows:

- **An increase to the Netball Australia Administration Fee (inclusive of the Participant Pack) resulting in a \$4.00 (GST Inclusive) increase to \$26.00 (GST Inclusive);**
- Netball WA will **NOT** increase the Initial Participant Fee, it will remain at **\$37.00 (GST Inclusive)**, however the Repeat Participant Fee will increase by **\$1.00 (GST Inclusive) to \$23.00 (GST Inclusive);**
- This will see the **NetSetGO Initial Fee become \$63.00 (GST Inclusive) and the NetSetGO Repeat Fee become \$23.00 (GST Inclusive).**

WITHDRAWING A PLAYER AFTER THE WDNA LOCK OUT DATE April 8

Any application for refunds after the **first playing date** must be made immediately in writing to the Association Manager. **Refunds will only be considered with a medical certificate.** Should the application be successful an administration fee of \$20 may be applied.

WITHDRAWING A TEAM

Anyone withdrawing a team from the Association **after WDNA** lock out Day shall forfeit all monies paid.

CODES OF BEHAVIOUR:

It is the **club's responsibility** for ensuring that their members and spectators are aware of and abide by the WDNA code of behaviours.

PERMITS

No permits will be approved for playing down unless accompanied by medical documentation or inclusion for medical reasons.

Clubs may apply for a permit for a player wishing to play up two (2) age groups from where they are age eligible.

Players may play up one age group from where they are age eligible without a permit
